

## **Grade 10 Academic Math - Review for Final Exam**

There are three things you should do in studying for your final exam. They are:

1. Make study notes.

Go through your notes and write down any formulas and key ideas for each lesson. Another excellent source of information for this is the “key ideas” in the textbook.

2. Redo all tests.

Don't just read the tests over. Redo means cover up the solutions (which you have since you were told to copy corrections from the board when we took up the tests) and do the questions again on a different sheet of paper. Then check your solution. Do the following questions.

Pg.587#1all,(3 – 6)all  
and  
Do the review questions on the handout titled:
